rent them well and truly paid by the said parties of the second part, after before the seal
ing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted han-
gained sold, alined, enfeoffed, released, censys and confirmed and by these presents Do grant
hang gain, sell alien, enfeoff, release Cenoy and confirm unto the said parties of the sec-
ond part, their heirs and assigns All that piece or parcel of a tract of land situate
in the Township of Hickiminetas in the County of Armstrong and state of Pennsyl-
vania, Bounded and described as follows to wit: Beginning at a Hickory and
from thence by lands formerly of Arch Leech and now John & Jane Barr of
which this was a part north twenty one perches to a post, thence north seventy eight
degrees East six perches to a post thence north forty two perches to a Locust, thence
by lands of David Fisher now Jacksons East fifty nine and one tenth perches
to a post, thence south twenty two and one half degrees East ninety two perches to stone
thence by lands of John Cochran west ninety seven and one half perches to the
place of Beginning containing Thirty nine acres and ninety five perches. & strict

Gailey, J. A. Grim & I. E.
