This Indenture, Made the twenty seventh day of November In the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty six Between Joseph Grim of Kiskiminetas Township
 To Armstrong County and State of Penns^ds^d versus his wife of the one part and doth
 Joseph Orr^d One of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth: That the said Joseph
 Grim and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred
 and fifty dollars lawful money of the United States, to them in hand paid by the
 said Joseph Orr at or before the sealing or delivery hereof, the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
 knowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released and confirmed, and
 by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, release, and confirm, unto the
 said Joseph Orr his heirs and assigns all that certain tract or parcel of Land situated
 in Kiskiminetas Township and County of Armstrong bounded and described as follows:
 Beginning at a stone corner thence by Land of Scott North eighty degrees East forty
 two perches to a post thence by Residue of said Tract North eight degrees East
 forty perches to a post thence North seventeen degrees East twenty and one half
 perches to a post thence North eighty degrees west Sixty two perches to a post thence
 South ten degrees west Sixty and one half perches to the place of Beginning containing
 twenty two acres and allowance at the rate of being part of a larger tract of Land
 conveyed to said Joseph Grim by decree from John George and wife dated the twenty
 second day of November and Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and
 thirty nine recorded in abstracting in Deed Book Vol 13, page 319. Reference being
 had thereto will more fully appear. Together with all and singular

Recd. grantees, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, release, and confirm, unto the said John George his heirs and assigns. All that certain piece or parcel of Land situate in His Eminence's Township, Armstrong bounded and described as follows Beginning at a stone corner thence by Line of State Road eighty degrees East Sixty two perches to a post thence by running of said tract North eighty degrees East forty perches to a post thence North seventeen degrees East Twenty one half perches to a post thence North eighty degrees West Sixty two perches to a post thence South ten degrees West Sixty one half perches to the place of Beginning containing Twenty two acres and allowance at six per cent &c Being part of a large tract of Land conveyed to Joseph Orr by deed from John George & wife dated the Twenty day of November A.D. 1839. Recorded in Armstrong in Deed Book Vol. 13 Page 319.
